Reading every night



- Continue daily reading signing the reading record diary
- Read magazines, comics
- Non-fiction, information
- Poems

Science

- Create a bird feeder and record how many different species of birds visit your garden.
- Make a collection of different materials (card, plastic etc.) and find different ways of grouping them (hard, soft, dull etc.).
- How many different habitats can you think of? Cut out some photographs of habitats and make a collage.

Practise your times tables



- Number bonds to 20 and 100
- 2, 5 and 10 times tables multiplication and division facts.
- Read the time on the clock to the nearest 15 minutes.

Art and Design/DT

- Can you create a setting for a mythical creature?
- Draw a picture of yourself in your favourite place.

Geography/History

- Find out about famous tunnels around the world.
- Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the 7 continents and 5 oceans.

Learn spellings



- Ask someone to test you
- Is there a spelling rule that helps?
- Identify the tricky part & a way to remember it
- Look on the school website for other ideas.

Reading and Writing

- Questions around books. Who are the main characters? What is the setting? What time of year does your story happen in? Why are characters kind /unkind to one another? How can you tell they get on? What might happen next? How will characters be feeling throughout the story as things happen? Does the story have any similarities to other stories?
- Can you write your own story about a tunnel?
