

Child Friendly E- Safety Policy

This policy has been developed by our School Councillors with the aim to keep children safe on the internet at home and at school.

Why do we like the internet?

- It's lots of fun!
- We can play games and watch videos.
- We can use it for schoolwork and homework.
- We can learn new things.

Why can the internet be dangerous?

- People can steal your personal information.
- People could make you feel uncomfortable.
- We might see or hear unkind things.
- Not everything online is okay for children.

Why do we need an E-Safety Policy?

- To keep children safe on the internet at home and at school.
- To make sure children know what to do if they see or hear something that makes them feel uncomfortable, worried or upset.

Our Internet Rules:

- We must ask a grown-up to use the internet.
- We only use websites that a grown-up has asked us to use.
- We never give out our personal information.
- We keep calm and show a grown-up if something we have seen or heard has upset us.
- We must never look for, save or send anything that could be unkind, nasty or not for children.

If we have a problem when we are using the internet, what should we do?

- Keep calm and tell a grown-up straight away.
- Show a grown-up what has made us feel upset.

How does our school keep children safe on the internet?

- Grown-ups watch us on the internet and tell us how to use it safely.
- The school blocks things that are not okay for children.
- We never use our personal information.
