Dear Parents / Carers

**IMPORTANT - Change to entrance into school.**

As mentioned in our recent newsletter, we are excited to inform you that the planned building works to improve our school and the grounds will be starting from the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2024.

Our early years outdoor area is being transformed into a sensory, activity and adventure area completed with textured surfaces, a climbing tree and covered areas. We are also having the render on the building removed and reapplied and new windows. As you can appreciate this is a lot of construction work that will last approximately 35 weeks but as I am sure you will agree – we shall look amazing afterwards and have no more leaking windows!

**Due to the work on the early years area the path at the side will be closed for approximately 4 weeks from the 29<sup>th</sup> January to 28<sup>th</sup> February. This means that access from the front to the back of school will be closed. We therefore need to make the following changes to the way children come into school from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January.**

**Nursery – Continue to come in through the nursery doors but with access from Grange Lane only.**

**Reception – Continue to come in through the reception doors but with access from Grange Lane only.**

**Year 1 – Please access school through the back gate from King Georges and entrance will be through the classrooms as normal.**

**Year 2 – Please access school from Grange Lane and queue at the main office doors. Entrance and exit for year 2 will be through these doors for this period due to the area close to year 2 entrance being under construction.**

There will be no change to the collection points of the afterschool clubs. If you have children in more than one year group and this will affect you, please let us know so we can try to put your children together for collection at the end of the day.

**There will be no access through the side gate and the path around the edge of school. Please ensure children are kept away from the designated build spaces and any building compounds.**
